Evaluate current technology solutions to include web-based and mobile application psychiatric bed registry that serves as a platform for inpatient hospital bed openings. Collaborate with key stake-holders in the community/county for interest, feasibility, implementation and support of a shared registry tool. Initiate a core team of multidisciplinary key stakeholders within the community to survey interest, evaluate need, and gain support of a psychiatric bed registry. Evaluate current and future options for a real-time electronic bed tracking systems. This project will require a phased approach. Will begin with a 90-day workout using the Lean Six Sigma PI method and will readjust accordingly based on PI direction. Since this commitment relies on community partner involvement, will anticipate several sub-committee formations in addressing identified systems, standards, protocols, and finding.
