### Action Plan

1. Evidence based clinical practice: Improve and update the knowledge of medical staffs by monthly obstetric meeting to spread the knowledge pearl of the latest medical evidence of postpartum hemorrhage. 2. Scheduled simulation training: Same as ACLS, we arrange simulation training to allow our medical staffs keep in mind that emergency might occur to any pregnant women and make them be experienced with all the procedures. 3. Training of new staffs, including medical students: for every trainees in obstetrical department, we let them practice actionable steps by groups to let them have the basic knowledge of postpartum hemorrhage. 4. Admission assessment and informed consent: every patient admitted to obstetric ward will receive assessment of risks of postpartum hemorrhage and also education about that postpartum hemorrhage could happen to any pregnancy women and the medical methods we might practice.
