Maniapure Foundation and Telesalud Intl Corp are happy to announce their support of the Patient Safety Movement Foundation (PSMF) and their mission to eliminate preventable patient deaths in U.S. hospitals by 2020 (0X2020), and contribute to expand that experience to other countries in Latin America.

Maniapure Foundation along with Telesalud Intl Corp provide healthcare across 5 Latin American countries such as Venezuela, Ecuador, Colombia, Bolivia and Peru. Their services reach 20 rural clinics via telemedicine as well as serve close to a million individuals through telephonic medical assistance. The Foundation also provides educational programs in the prevention and early diagnosis of apparently healthy children with learning disabilities caused by anemia, visual, and hearing limitations.

The Maniapure Foundation will demonstrate alliance with PSMF by committing to the following:

1. Joining the Patient Safety Movement Foundation as a committed partner
2. Spreading the 0X2020 mission through healthcare professionals affiliated with the Maniapure Foundation
3. Educating clinicians about the goals of the Movement and how they can implement Actionable Patient Safety Solutions (APSS), particularly related to assessing for anemia in children and applicable processes that can positively impact care given through the virtual triage center.
4. Aiding in the education of early prevention and diagnosis pertaining to children with learning disabilities caused by anemia, visual, and hearing limitations.

We at the Maniapure Foundation are excited to sign this letter as a formal commitment to collaborate with the Patient Safety Movement to improve patient safety, beginning in 2017 and continuing through the two-year pilot program, and beyond through 2020.
